

Wharfe Valley Primary Schools Cross-Country League 2023 / 24

We are delighted to confirm that the Cross Country League for the school year 2023 – 24 will be made up of five events. The events are over the autumn and spring terms with a KS2 Relay event in March to conclude the series. Organising schools will ensure, on 'their' race day that individual races are arranged for KS1 (Reception, year 1 and 2) and KS2 (years 3 – 6) children (the exception to this will be Addingham, where due to Health and Safety and consideration to the school's neighbours we will be running a KS2 event only). The organising school will be responsible for presenting certificates. For the purposes of the League we will only use the results from years 3 to 6 and in advance would like to thank Addingham, All Saints', Ben Rhydding, Ghyll Royd and Westville schools for allowing 'their' race to be included in the League.

In the past there have been no restrictions on the number of children that a school may have competing (and supporters attending), but **could schools make sure that children compete in one race only per event; children should run in their year group and not a younger year to ensure each race is fair for all those competing.** This will be communicated to each school holding an event and will form part of their 'invitation' to the other 11 schools taking part. We would appreciate your support in ensuring all children and any supporters that may attend with a child are aware and respectful of these requests to ensure we are able to run the event fairly.

Individual League

For the purposes of the League and event organising we will ONLY be inviting and therefore using the results of children participating from the following 12 Wharfedale schools.

There will be 5 individual events this season, at all events races for Reception – year 6 will take place (except Addingham where KS2 only will race):

Saturday 14th October – Addingham (**KS2 only**)

Saturday 18th November – Ghyll Royd

Saturday 3rd February – Ben Rhydding

Saturday 2nd March – All Saints' (at Ilkley Pool)

The 8 individual leagues are:

League points are allocated based on an individual's best 4 out of 5 results (unless a race has to be cancelled due to bad weather in which case the organisers of the League will notify schools / individuals at the Nell Bank Relays how the results have been compiled).

School Team Relay – Nell Bank – 16th March 2024

At the end of the series we will organise relay races, followed by the presentation of awards and certificates to individuals. Ilkley Harriers will support the League by providing the engraved plates for the first six finishers in the 8 individual Leagues and certificates to the top finishers in each League (provided they have taken part in the number of races chosen for League positions i.e. if five events take place, the best four results will be used).

These relays will take place at Nell Bank on Saturday 16th March 2024 and they will be restricted to KS2 children from the 12 League schools. More specific details will be given to schools nearer the time, we will use the same format as previous years with teams of 3 and run separate U9 (Years 3 & 4) and U11 (Years 5 & 6) relay races. There will be two courses (U9) and (U11) with all three team members running over the same course. 3 categories - Boys, Girls, Mixed.
